The Trust Board will be a significant contributor in the Performing Arts Centre Building Project as part of the College's Centennial Celebrations (1912 – 2012) and is requesting the following donations in 2012:

***Board of Trustees School Donation – Paid to the College** – (There will be NO FUNDRAISING activities)

Families of students are asked to pay the School Donation. This contributes to the purchase of materials and administration for the Religious Education Programme, the purchase of sports and recreation equipment, library, educational entertainment, I.D. card, Retreats, subsidies for travel for class trips, and other such expenditure as the Board considers necessary and which is not covered by Government grants to the College. In addition to these items, the donation includes the student's payment for the College Magazine. In line with Ministry guidelines, we make it clear that this payment is a discretionary one.

COLLEGE CENTENNIAL CELEBRATIONS - PERFORMING ARTS CENTRE BUILDING PROJECT AND PROPRIETORS DONATIONS 2012

The Mission Colleges Lower Hutt Trust Board is the Proprietor of the college. Our College – as part of the State Integrated Colleges- is not entitled to receive any additional funding from the Ministry of Education for major refits and upgrades of college buildings. The Trust Board works in partnership with the Board of Trustees and has used its own funds to upgrade Fourvière House and Atawhai in the past and has now taken out a substantial loan for the building of a Performing Arts Suite.

Miscellaneous Expenses:

Field Trips, Sport, Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme, extra courses, school photographs and other such activities may mean additional expenses at various times during the student's education. These amounts vary each year and will generally be subject to G.S.T.

Remission of Dues, Donations or other expenses:

Any parent whose circumstances make it difficult to meet the costs mentioned above should apply to the Principal for consideration of a full or partial remission.

Attendance Dues – Paid to Catholic Schools Board

Attendance Dues are payable at **\$716.00 per student** per year. The Proprietor of the College reserves the right to alter the Attendance Dues at any time. This payment is to be paid direct to Catholic Schools Board Limited.

When the Dues cannot be paid as and when they are due, or a full payment cannot be made, parents should discuss such problems with the Principal, so that the appropriate advice can be given to the collecting agent and other arrangements made.
